### Climatic conditions :

January : Winter exceptionally mild

February : Particularly warm – Early bud burst.

March / April : Cold with frost.

May : Warm, sunny. The first flowers appeared around 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> May

June : Dry and warm until 15<sup>th</sup> July

August : Warm and sunny

September : Warm and sunny

October : Very sound grapes

Conclusion : A general success. All the varieties, even the late ones, have perfectly matured, thanks to ideal climatic conditions.

### Tasting notes :

Deep, dark red wine.

Very powerful nose characterized by notes of very mature fruits mixed with hints of caramel and spices.

In the mouth this wine is a true explosion of flavours and aromas, a complex combination of velvety nuances : coffee, cocoa and fine woody tastes.

Very long aromatic persistent aftertaste.

This is a rich and concentrated stunning wine which should be kept.
