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« ... The biggest surprise came in Saint-Estèphe where the young wines are often difficult to taste because of their tannic structure. Château Phélan Ségur, which under Dausse's management has catapulted into the top ranks, produced a positively gorgeous wine in 2014 (94). Though refined and polished, it retained the attractive gritty earthiness that makes the wines of St. Estèphe so engaging. At \$35 a bottle, it is one of the best buys of the vintage. »
